



The Year In Epidemiology - 2018

Our 2018 calendar of key events in epidemiology contains 175 listings to help you stay in touch and up to date on the latest developments in the field. The calendar items represent an almost 50% increase compared to the number of listings published last year in our 2017 calendar.
